ACTIVITY DESCRIPTION

Frontal lecture

In the context of this lesson, the following aspects are addressed in the further education of parents:

- How does homeschooling work?
- Equipment for homeschooling
- What to look out for in everyday homeschooling?
- Safe surfing for children and teenagers
- Digital tools for homeschooling (learning apps)

These topics are prepared and presented in the form of a PowerPoint presentation by the teacher.

TIP: The PPP is designed so that it can also be used for self-study by parents.

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ACTIVITY DESCRIPTION

Emphasis will be placed on digital tools for homeschooling. Quizlet and LearningApps will be presented. These are intended to encourage parents to work on learning content together with the children and to show that learning with Internet-enabled devices is meaningful and can be fun.

TIP: At the end of the collection of methods, links for using the digital resources are listed so that parents can further educate themselves through self-study.

ACTIVITY DESCRIPTION

Work in groups After the frontal teaching, the participants are divided into groups and given tasks for LearningApps and Quizlet, which they have to implement together.

1	Search for already created exercises in the category Media and Computer Science on the topic History of the Internet. Try an exercise. If you don't find what you are looking for, here is a link to an exercise: https://learningapps.org/6078789		
2	Find an already created exercise in a category of your choice and send your daughter/son the link of this exercise by email.		
3	Try to create your own app. To do this, click on the "Create App" button. Create an app "Assign pairs". You could, for example, pair countries and national capitals or mountains and countries!		
4	Find an exercise that would suit your daughter/son and change it a little. To do this, click on the button "Edit app".		

Afterward, the individual groups present their results and give feedback.
